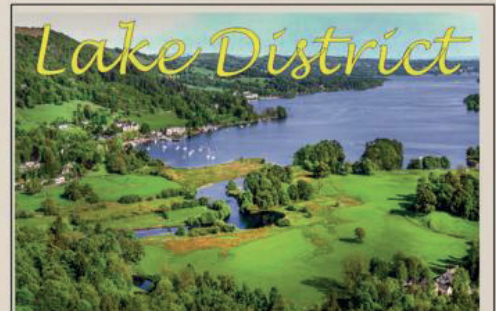

## Some notable landmarks of the SLMDA UK

### Dr Mahendra Gonsalkorale (Editor )

SLMDA is the oldest Sri Lankan professional association in the UK. The inaugural meeting was held at the Ceylon Tea Centre in London on Saturday the 27th March 1982 with Dr Seetha Siriwardena in the chair

The original aims of the Sri Lanka Doctors Association as it was called then, were to help Sri Lankan medical schools and to create a forum for the SL doctors to exchange academic ideas and social pleasantries.

The first Christmas Dance held on the 31st December 1982 was attended by a massive gathering of 454

The first Annual General Meeting and Scientific Meeting held outside London was in Bisley, Surrey in 2003.

The first academic meeting was held on the 19th of March 1988 under the aegis of Dr Punchihewa and Dr Izmeth.

The first Dinner Dance of the SLMDA was held on the 26th of June 1982 at the Cunard International Hotel in London. Ticket price was £12.50.

The SLMDA was recognised as a registered charity (No:800821) by the UK Charity Commissioner in 1990. Also in the same year, SLMDA held its first Dinner Dance outside London, in Warrington, Cheshire

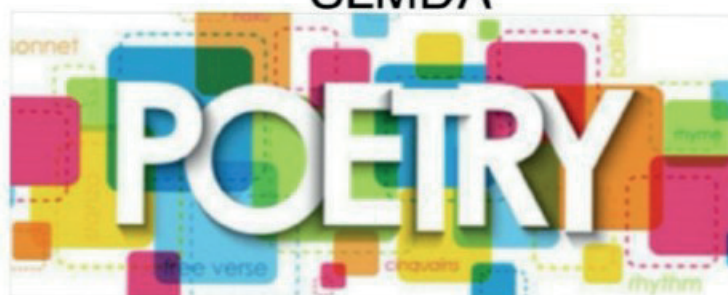

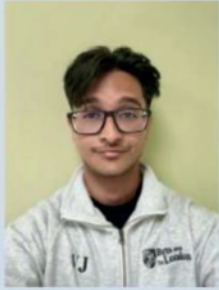

## The 19<sup>th</sup> Law Medical held on 17<sup>th</sup> August 2025. Report by Ajantha Jayatunga



The 19<sup>th</sup> Law Medical match was planned to be held at the usual venue in Harrow on the 19<sup>th</sup> of July 2025. With glorious weather in June we all eagerly anticipated another exciting encounter. Unfortunately as the day approached, the weather forecasts spelt gloom. After consultation with the ground staff it was clear that the match would have to be abandoned. There was no availability for the grounds for the rest of the summer either.

### The Frantic search

A Frantic search for an alternative date and venue ensued. Priyantha Siriwardane suggested Chelmers park in Chelmsford and confirmed availability of two smaller pitches. And an adjacent netball court. Priyantha took on the enormous task of making sure the officials were arranged and all the local arrangements sorted. As fortune would have it the main pitch became available due to a last minute cancellation of a local club game.

The weather on the day was sunny but not scorching. The pitch seemed to be hard and true with a thin covering of grass and the outfield appeared parched and fast.

Several injuries prevented the SLMDA fielding their best team. Fortunately a couple of the seniors became available. The youthful skipper Matiss Siyambalapatiya energised the team. The Law team which lacked a Warnapala name for the first time probably since the inception of the Law Medical encounters, was led by Delrik Adhikari.

### The Lawyers stumble

The toss was again won by the Law captain Delrik, true to the trend over the past many years. After some deliberation the lawyers elected to bat first. An unusually slow start by Legal's standards with the opening bowlers Dinath Alwis and Sisira Aththaragama applying tremendous pressure. The first 5 overs yielded 5 runs for 1 wkt. On their back foot from the start they lost the first 4 wickets for 39 runs. An excellent catch in the gully by Vinod and another caught and bowled by Dinath set the tone. When last year's centurian Hussein was snapped up sharply by Dinil Siriwardane behind the wickets the lawyers were in dire straits. A partial recovery and rebuild ensued when skipper Delrik was joined by Dineth Seneviratne. The latter chose to attack as the best form of defence with some lusty blows until he was trapped by Neal Seneviratne's wily spin. When Delrick departed to a very smart run out to a direct throw by Dinath Alwis the writing was on the wall. 6 down for 119 and anticipation of a quick run through the lower order was in the air particularly when the 7<sup>th</sup> wicket fell at 128 in the 24<sup>th</sup> over.

As the part time bowling attack seemed to lose the radar, the steady heads of the lower order batters prevailed. A rear-guard action by Usitha Karunasekera (31), Gayan Perera (32 N.O.) Ananda Arun Joseph (10) and Romiru Thanthirimudali (8) bolstered the score and the lawyers totalled a respectable 228 runs all out.

## The 19<sup>th</sup> Law Medical held on 17<sup>th</sup> August 2025. Report by Ajantha Jayatunga

*Cntd...*For the SLMDA wickets were shared by Neal Siriwardane 2/34 off 9, Bhanuka Senasinghe 3 for 34 off 4 overs, and a wicket each for Sisira Aththaragama, Dinath Alwis, Matiss Siyambalapitiya and Kriss Jasinaratchi. Unfortunately there were 63 extra runs added to the Legals score of which 51 runs being wides. The Doctors showed a lot of discipline and purpose on the field holding their catches, with excellent ground fielding. Special mention must be made of excellent captaincy by young Matiss Siyambalapitiya who manipulated his limited bowling resources expertly. His enthusiasm was infectious and the youthful team responded.

### Medics romp home.

A duo of Dinils opened the batting for the medics. Dinil Kodituwakku was full of elegance with crisp timing particularly on the offside and Dinil Siriwardane played with unhurried assurance. 92 runs in a steady partnership were added before an uppish stroke by Kodituwakku (40/five 4s) was grabbed at mid wicket by Hussain in the 14<sup>th</sup> over off Usith Karunasekera. This paved the way for skipper Matiss to enter the fray. He attacked the bowling from the word go and runs were accumulated with relative ease. The second wicket partnership yielded another brisk 118 runs in 18 overs. In trying to turn over the strike for his younger partner who was nearing his century, Matiss (58 with 6 fours), ran himself out unfortunately 13 runs short of the target.

Young Dinil Siriwardane was on the field all day. First behind the wickets a very accomplished performance with the gloves especially with some wayward bowling on both sides of the wicket. Two catches and a stumping being his reward. Opening the batting for SLMDA he scored a chanceless unbeaten century in a very assured and mature manner. The young man showed great composure well beyond his years. He will be a huge asset for the SLMDA if we can secure his services in the future. The Medics achieved their target with a mere 3 wickets down, to the jubilation of their supporters who had a long wait for this success.

This young team, thus ended the stranglehold that The ASSLUK had on the Law-Medical trophy. We have never had the pleasure of holding the trophy since it was donated in 2018. The challenge will be to try and hold on to it in the years to come as I am sure The Lawyers will try their utmost to wrestle it back next year

The ASSLUK seconds batted **32.2 overs for 180 runs** with Manoj Warnapala returning to the crease remaining unbeaten with 41 having run out of partners, D Aluvihare 31 and R Aluvihare 25 were the other main contributors. The wicket takers being Sisira Kankanamge 2 for 17, A Muthulingam 2 for 33 and Janaka Weeratunga 3 for 20.

*Sri Lanka Medical and Dental Association is a non- political, non-racial organization respecting equality and diversity without any religious affiliations. It was founded in 1982 with a membership of Sri Lankan doctors & dentists exceeding 400 at present.*

*The main aim of the SLMDA is to assist undergraduate medical & dental education in Sri Lanka. However the constitution has recently been extended to support humanitarian causes of exceptional significance to Sri Lanka. (E.g. 2004 Tsunami)..*

**Support to Sri Lanka is provided in the following ways.**

### **Annual General Meeting & Spring Scientific Sessions**

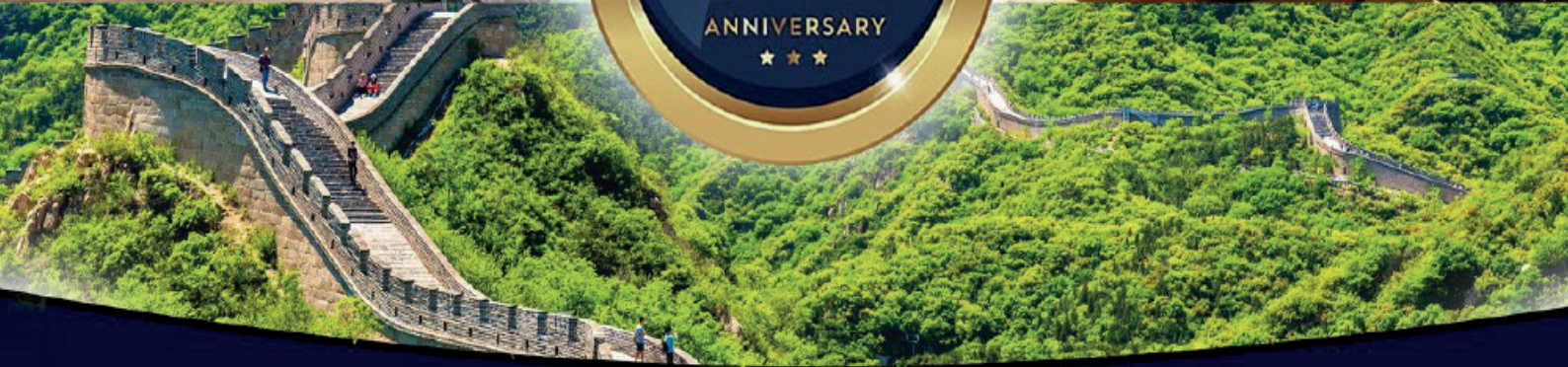
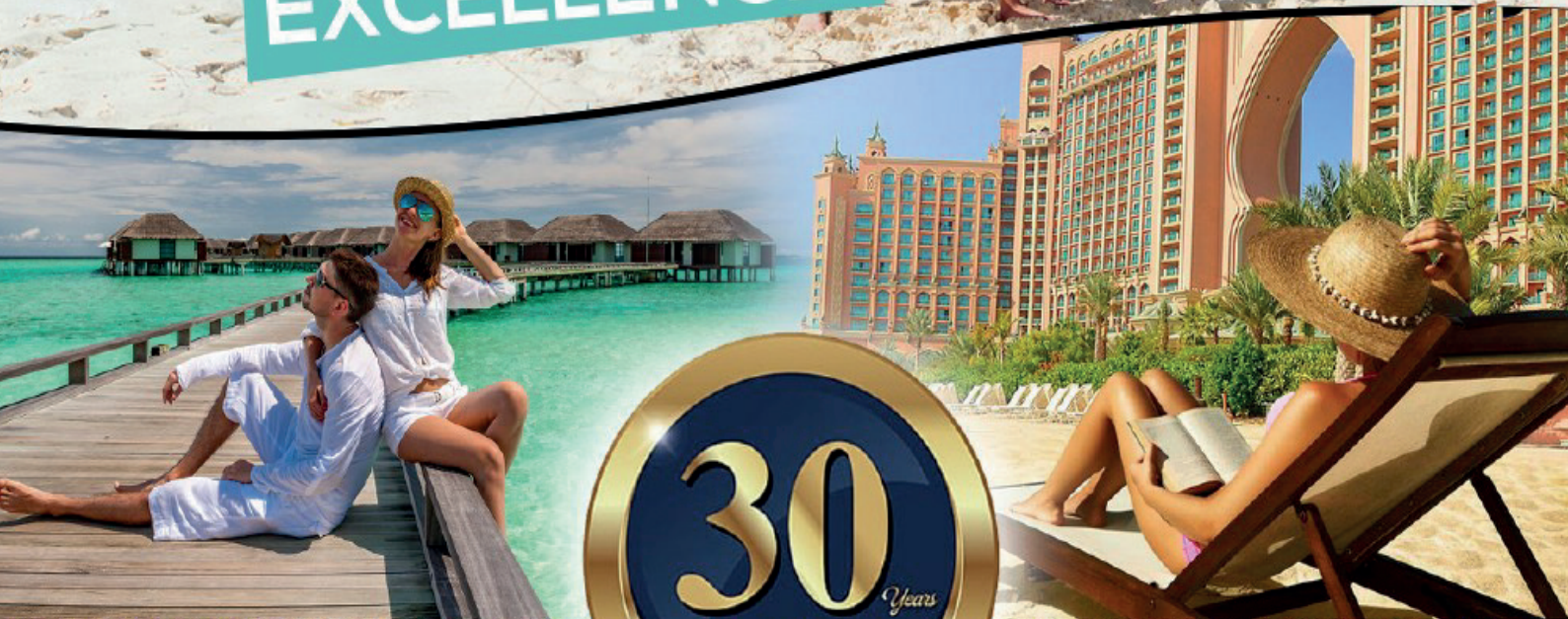
